School Bond Election
(Waverly School District 145)
In The State of Nebraska
\$89,900,000

"Shall Lancaster County School District 0145 (Waverly School District 145) in the State of Nebraska (the "District") issue general obligation bonds of the District in an aggregate stated principal amount not to exceed Eighty Nine Million Nine Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$89,900,000), for the purpose of providing funds to pay the costs of additions, renovations and improvements of the District's existing buildings and facilities, and providing furniture, equipment and apparatus for the same., which may include the following: security and technology additions and improvements; heating, ventilation and cooling improvements and upgrades; reconfiguration of existing facilities and replacement of furnishings and equipment; and additions, renovations and improvements to the existing buildings and facilities for or related to the High School, Middle School, Intermediate School, Hamlow Elementary School and Eagle Elementary School Buildings; such bonds to be issued from time to time, to bear interest at such rate or rates, to be sold at such prices and to become due at such time or times as may be fixed by, or determined at the direction of, the Board of Education; and

"Shall the District cause to be levied and collected annually a special levy of taxes against all the taxable property in the District sufficient in rate and amount to pay the principal of and interest on such bonds as the same become due?"

FOR such Bonds and tax

In compliance with Section 32-811, R.R.S. Nebr., 1943 and Suppl., in those cases where the number of candidates properly filed for nomination at the primary election does not exceed two (2) for each position to be filled, any such candidates shall be declared nominated and their names shall not appear on the primary election ballot and shall advance to the general election.

Also - in compliance with Section 32-811 (1)(b), Partisan County offices will auto advance and shall not appear on the primary election ballot when only one candidate, or no candidate, has filed to be the party nominee.
