DESCRIPTION OF WORK

Under direct supervision of an assigned foreman, is responsible for semi-skilled work in the operation of trucks, tractors, and other light construction equipment.

EXAMPLES OF WORK

Operates various types of trucks (material, utility, sign, flat-bed, pickup), farm-type tractors with attachments, rollers, and other automotive and mobile equipment; operates chain saws and fungicide sprayers; cuts weeds, erects highway signs, paints highway stripes, cleans roadsides and ditches; installs guardrails and culverts; hauls materials, dirt, and debris; loads and unloads trucks; removes snow; performs minor maintenance and repair on equipment; can be assigned to operate front-end loaders, graders, and other complex equipment for training, emergencies, and related purposes; performs related work as required.

QUALIFICATIONS

Working knowledge of the operation of automotive equipment; working knowledge of traffic laws; skill in the safe operation of automotive equipment and less complex agricultural machinery; ability to do manual labor involving bending, lifting, carrying, and other similar motions; ability to grasp and carry out routine oral and written instructions; ability to maintain working relationships with co-workers and the public; ability to fill out worksheets.
